

How to Remove an Email Account from an iPhone


- The steps below apply to the following models:
 - iPhone X / XS / XS Max / XR
 - iPhone 8 / 8 Plus
 - iPhone 7 / 7 Plus
 - iPhone SE
 - iPhone 6 / 6 Plus / 6s / 6s Plus
 - iPhone 5s

Steps




1 Open your iPhone's **Settings** . Tap the Settings app icon, which resembles a grey box with gears on it.




2 Scroll down and tap **Accounts & Passwords**. It's near the middle of the Settings page.



3 **Select an account.** In the "ACCOUNTS" section, tap the email account (e.g., **Gmail**) that you want to remove from your iPhone.



4 Scroll down and tap **Delete Account**. It's a red button at the bottom of the page.



5 Tap **Delete Account** when prompted. Doing so will immediately remove the email account and any accompanying data from your iPhone.
