

Test-out Option for Current or Former LPGA Class A Tour Player Members

The PGA Board of Directors, at the February 2006 meeting, passed the reciprocity concessions for current or former LPGA Class A Members. Current or former LPGA Class A Tour Player members will be given the opportunity to utilize the reciprocity process of testing out of the Pre-Qualifying Level and Level 1, 2 and 3 curriculums.

This procedure is not available for reciprocation of LPGA Class B or LPGA Apprentice Member requirements. Such individuals will be required to complete the PGM Associate Program in its entirety, including the PAT. For any questions or to discuss this process further, please contact the Membership Services Department at (800) 474-2776.

- STEP 1 Be a current or former exempt member of the LPGA or Symetra Tour.
- STEP 2 Contact the PGA of America to obtain a tour player application for direct election into Class A-3 Tour Player membership.
- STEP 3 Play 12 or more events per calendar year and retain LPGA membership to maintain Class A3 membership in the PGA of America.
- STEP 4 Accumulate 30 work experience credits. Credits are earned from playing in LPGA or Symetra Tour events at ½ credit per event provided 2 or more rounds are played. Maximum credits on the LPGA Tour are 12 credits per calendar year. The Symetra Tour maximum credits per calendar year are 6; to a lifetime maximum of 18. Tour credits can be carried forward to the required 30 credits for club professional membership provided the individual has not regained amateur status. Regaining amateur status or participating in amateur golf events shall negate all prior work experience credits.
- STEP 5 If and when you are no longer eligible to play for the LPGA, you can transfer to the PGA of America's club professional division to begin the "test-out" process which consists of a Pre-Qualifying Level course (this test must be passed within six (6) months of purchase) followed by knowledge tests for all 3 levels of the PGM Associate Program. All 3 levels of testing must be successfully passed within 2 years of the date of purchasing the Level 1 materials. You will have no affiliation with the PGA or any of its Sections until all requirements have been completed and you have been elected to Class A membership.
- STEP 6 Complete the History Worksheet.
- STEP 7 Obtain eligible employment. An individual <u>must</u> be primarily employed in an area required by an active classification. The eligible classifications and their definitions can be viewed on PGA's website: <u>www.PGA.org</u>, Path to Membership, then the PGM Associate Program, then scrolling to Eligible Employment.
- STEP 8 Complete a Background Check. To complete the Background Check, log onto https://www.emplscreen.com/pga.asp and follow the instructions. (If you have been convicted of a felony, misdemeanor or equivalent, you should submit documentation to the PGA Membership Department to determine your eligibility for PGA Membership prior to proceeding. Per the PGA Code of Ethics, certain transgressions are cause for permanent preclusion to PGA Membership.)

This procedure is not available for reciprocation of LPGA Class B or LPGA Apprentice Member requirements. Such individuals will be required to complete the PGM Associate program in its entirety, including the PAT. Current or former Class A members of Australian, British, Canadian, German, New Zealand and South African PGA's, or

Current or former Class A-3 members of The PGA of America who have accumulated 30 work experience credits, or

Current/former LPGA Class A Tour Players or current/former LPGA Class A Teaching Professionals who have been approved for the test-out option of the PGM Associate Program

To become a PGA of America club professional member, individuals who meet the above criteria can select from two (2) options:

- a) Complete The PGA Professional Golf Management Program in its entirety; or
- b) Select the "test-out" option by passing the Pre-Qualifying and Levels 1, 2 and 3 tests at test centers. Purchasing access to Pre-Qualifying Level and Level 1, 2 and 3 course/study materials is required.

- i) If any test is failed, it will be necessary to register for another appointment.
- ii) If any test is failed twice, it will be necessary to complete the PGM Associate Program. Program in its entirety.
- iii) If all 3 levels are not completed within 2 years from the date of purchasing the Level 1 study materials, it will be necessary to complete the PGM Associate Program its entirety.

You will schedule and pay for your testing appointment directly with the test center. You will receive an email from PSI (the testing company) to pay for and schedule your tests.

Only applicable and authorized test related materials (un-marked USGA Rules of Golf Book for Qualifying Level and Level 1) will be allowed in the testing room. A calculator will be provided by the testing center. Absolutely no items such as newspapers, books, cell phones, cameras, pagers, pens or pencils will be allowed in the testing room.
