

Frequently asked questions about the 2019 PGA Championship



Q: How do I purchase tickets?

A: To ensure widespread access to the most in-demand ticket types, PGA Championship tickets are sold exclusively through a free, no obligation, online registration process. Fans can visit www.pgachampionship.com to hold their place -- first come, first served -- to purchase tickets when they go on sale in August of 2018. The earlier fans register the better, as historically many of the most popular ticket types sell out in advance of the event. Once registered, fans will receive an email communication notifying them of their purchase window.

Q: How much does each ticket cost?

Q: What is the difference between a Wanamaker Club ticket package and a Season Grounds ticket package?

A: Season Grounds tickets include access to the Championship Grounds for all seven days (Monday through Sunday). Each Season Grounds Ticket Package comes in the form of seven individual daily tickets (one for Monday, one for Tuesday, etc.). Wanamaker Club tickets include week-long access to the Championship Grounds, as well as entrance into the Wanamaker Club and come in the form of seven individual daily tickets.

The Wanamaker Club is a climate-controlled venue located on-site at Bethpage State Park featuring upgraded food and beverage selections, expansive seating, flat screen televisions and Jumbotrons, executive restrooms and a large patio.

Q: What is the “Ultimate Wanamaker” ticket package?

A: As the PGA of America and Bethpage State Park look forward to the 2024 Ryder Cup, golf fans have a unique opportunity to reserve access to Ryder Cup tickets. With the purchase of an “Ultimate Wanamaker” package, fans will be able to bypass the standard Ryder Cup ticket random-draw process, guaranteeing their right to purchase two (2) week-long grounds passes for the 2024 Ryder Cup when they become available.

- The “Ultimate Wanamaker” package includes four (4) week long Wanamaker Club tickets for the 2019 PGA Championship.
- When 2024 Ryder Cup tickets become available, purchasers of the “Ultimate Wanamaker” package will be notified and provided a unique link to purchase two (2) week-long grounds passes. They will be required to log-in to their PGA Account using the same email address and password created upon purchasing the “Ultimate Wanamaker” package.
- The opportunity to bypass the lottery process and purchase two (2) week-long grounds passes for the 2024 Ryder Cup is non-transferrable.

Q: Can I purchase more than one (1) “Ultimate Wanamaker” ticket package?

A: Yes. Those purchasing two (2) “Ultimate Wanamaker” packages will gain access to four (4) week-long grounds passes for the 2024 Ryder Cup, and so on. There will be a limit of five (5) “Ultimate Wanamaker” packages per transaction providing access to a maximum of ten (10) week-long grounds passes for the 2024 Ryder Cup.

Q: How many “Ultimate Wanamaker” ticket packages will be sold?

A: The PGA does not disclose inventory limits for any of its ticket options. But only a limited number of these packages will be sold and that the expectation is they will sell out well in advance of the Championship.

Q: When is the Ryder Cup at Bethpage State Park?

A: The Ryder Cup, typically held in September, will be played at Bethpage State Park in 2024. Exact dates have yet to be determined.

Q: Does the PGA offer Junior tickets?

A: Juniors 17 years of age and younger will be admitted into the PGA Championship grounds FREE when accompanied by a ticketed adult. Each ticketed adult will be permitted four (4) junior grounds admissions per day at no additional charge. Junior tickets may be picked up onsite at the Admission Sales & Will Call Office at the Championship main entrance on the day of admission. Junior tickets cannot be obtained in advance and will be available regardless of a sellout.

Note: A junior ticket will NOT provide access to the Clubhouse or any hospitality area at the 2019 PGA Championship.

Q: Do juniors receive complimentary access to the Wanamaker Club?

A: A complimentary junior grounds ticket will NOT provide access into the Wanamaker Club. A nominal daily upgrade charge will apply for access. Junior upgrades can be purchased on the day of attendance at the Admission Sales & Will Call office located at the main entrance of the Championship.

Q: Does the PGA offer Military tickets?

A: To honor the men and women who serve our country in the United States Armed Forces, The PGA of America is pleased to offer Active Duty, Military Retirees, Active Reserve, National Guard and their accompanying guest (limit one) complimentary Daily Grounds tickets. Upon arrival, Military personnel must go to the Admissions and Will Call Office to present their Military ID in exchange for Daily Grounds tickets. *Please note these tickets cannot be upgraded to alternative venues but are eligible for the junior policy.*

Q: When will I receive my tickets?

A: Tickets will be mailed out to arrive in April 2019.

Q. Will there be a Will Call Office located on-site for ticket/credential pickup?

A. No. The Admissions and Will Call Office will not hold tickets or credentials for pick up. All tickets will be mailed to the address provided at time of purchase.

Q. Is there a limit to the number of tickets I can purchase?

A. Yes. There will be a limit of 10 tickets per package, per transaction.

Q: Where will I be able to park for the 2019 PGA Championship?

A: Complimentary parking will be available at Jones Beach State Park for all spectators. Shuttle service will be provided to and from the Championship Main Entrance and Jones Beach.

Alternate transportation is strongly recommended. Shuttle service will be provided between the Farmingdale Train Station and the Championship Main Entrance for those riding the Long Island Railroad, and a ride share/taxi drop-off lot will be available in close proximity to the Championship.

Please monitor PGAChampionship.com for continual transportation updates.

Q. What are the PGA Championship's admittance and re-admittance policies?

A. There will be no readmission into the Championship grounds for ticket holders. If you wish to leave and re-enter the grounds a new, unscanned ticket must be presented.
